Guidance Notes for Readers at Mass

Prepare your reading before Mass. Read it together with the other reading and the Gospel to understand its meaning.

Arrive early. Check where the readings are on the page & that they are the correct ones. If in doubt clarify with Deacon Alan or Fr. David.

Don't wear outdoor coats or anoraks when reading on the altar - you are in God's house!

Collect the Bidding Prayers from the pulpit when you arrive and have a quick read through them.

Approach the sanctuary confidently and with courtesy with your co-reader, making a full bow to the celebrant as you arrive at the foot of the altar steps.

Make sure the microphone is on and in the correct position for you. Without it you won't be heard beyond the first few rows.

Read slowly and clearly and speak up - Holy Angels is a large building and distorts rapid speech.

Do not read in a monotone - it's boring! Use your voice to bring real meaning to the reading. Vary the sound and tempo as you feel appropriate.

The microphone is directional so don't move from your position or you won't be heard.

Do not read the tag line at the top of the reading. It is unnecessary.

Look at the congregation at the beginning as you say "The First/Second Reading is from the"

Use your index finger to keep your place as you read.

Look at the congregation from time to time as you read. Don't keep your head bowed and eyes fixed on the text from beginning to end.

At the end of the reading allow a few seconds for reflection before saying "This is the Word of God"

Read out the response to the Psalm and then repeat with the congregation.

Enjoy the reading and its preparation and you will express this in your voice.

Leave a pause of a few seconds after reading a Bidding Prayer before saying the response e.g. "Lord Hear Us", to allow the Assembly time for reflection.

At the end of the reading withdraw from the pulpit and leave the altar discreetly down the altar steps bowing to the altar at the bottom of the steps.

Remember - You are Proclaiming the Word of God, not merely reading a page of words!
